Me, for I have not yet returned to the Father. Go instead to My brothers and tell them." Jesus disappeared and Mary Magdalene ran back again to tell the good news to the disciples that Jesus was alive! She confirmed what the others had also reported.

Christ is Risen!

CHRIST IS RISEN AND ALIVE TODAY!

"I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of Hell and of death" (Revelation 1:18).
